

List of Possible Awards to Honor Great SCNA Numismatists

SCNA Hall of Fame Member. (SCHOF)

- Award to honor present or past SCNA members for contributions to SCNA and hobby.
- Awarded to recipient or family member if deceased.
- Numbered certificates to be awarded.
- Award should be presented during a meal and with family members if possible.
- Recommendation shall be via a formal written nomination to the SCNA Board. Approval by formal vote by the SCNA Board.
- Note that this award is separate from HLM and does not require SCNA board membership for the nominee.

Honorary Life Membership: (SCHLM)

- Nominees require a Board majority vote as outlined in the by-laws. There should be no question as to the validity of this vote.
- Recipients: Austin M. Sheheen, Jr., Doris B. Whitehouse, James Vernon Epps, Donald D. McAlister (2), Tony Chibbaro, Pascal S. Brock, Arthur Darr, Randy Clark.

SCNA Lifetime Achievement Award: (SCLAW)

- 20 Years SCNA Support
- Must include SCNA Board Membership at some point during tenure
- Must have held a board level leadership role (above Board of Governors or equivalent) in their local club
- Literary contributions to hobby preferred.
- Recipient certificate and an additional \$50 off per table at all future SCNA shows subject to maintaining SCNA membership in good standing.
- Recommendation shall be via a formal written nomination to the SCNA Board. Approval by formal vote by the SCNA Board

SCNA Medal of Merit: (SCMOM)

- Members with significant contributions to their specific area of numismatic study regarded as leaders within their specific area of numismatics.
- Recommendation shall be via a formal written nomination to the SCNA Board. Approval by formal vote by the SCNA Board.

SCNA Numismatist of the Year: (SCNOTY)

- Sponsored by the board.
- As written - an individual SCNA member who has contributed to the hobby in some remarkable way.
- Notables Recipients: Tony Chibbaro (3), Samuel Norris (2), Hugh Shull, Jr., LoRan Ross, Pascal S. Brock, Will Gragg.

SCNA Literary Pilot Award: (SCLP)

- Best new SCNA Journal documentary or report in the last four issues by a **new author**.
- Awarded at the discretion of the YN Program Chairman (For YN's) or by the SCNA Board (For adults).
- If awarded to a YN the award should be titled "SCNA YN Literary Pilot Award".
- Adult award will be nominated by any board member to the SCNA Board for discussion and approved by SCNA Board majority vote. No formal written nomination is necessary beyond the published document in the SCNA Journal.

Scanner Literary Award: (SCSL)

- For best Scanner article in last year.
- Nominated by any board member to the SCNA Board for discussion and approved by SCNA Board majority vote. No formal written nomination is necessary beyond the published document in the SCNA Journal.
- Recipients: Robert W. Ross III (2), Sam Norris, Tony Chibbaro, Col. Stephen Ellsworth.

SCNA Club of the Year Award: (SCCOTY)

- As written - SCNA Member Club that provides exceptional activities for its members.
- sponsored by the Board. Nominated by any SCNA member.

SCNA YN Advisor of the Year Award: (SCYNAOTY)

- Adults directly supporting the SCNA or SC in-state YN programs.
- Supporting Advisor's local club (SCNA Member Club) also awarded \$100.
- Adult or YN award will be nominated by any board member to the SCNA Board for discussion and approved by SCNA Board majority vote. No formal written nomination is necessary beyond observance of the advisor efforts as observed by the nominating board member.

SCNA Seminar of the Year Award: (SCSOTY)

- Significant Numismatic Seminar Leaders recognized within and outside of the SCNA supporting the hobby without boundaries. Must have also lead seminars outside of their local club in another SCNA Member Club.

- Adult award will be nominated by any board member to the SCNA Board for discussion and approved by SCNA Board majority vote. No formal written nomination is necessary beyond the conduct of the seminar itself as observed by the nominating board member.

SCNA Dealer of the Year Award: (SCDOTY)

- 10 years as an SCNA Dealer with best Dealer Setup in pier group.
- By quorum of board members present at convention on Friday.
- Award Presented on Sunday.
- Bourse Chairman Congratulatory Certificate (generated by Bourse Chairman) and \$100 off the next years table fees.

SCNA New Dealer of the Year Award: (SCNDOTY)

- Best Dealer Setup of new to the SCNA Dealers (Under 5 years as SCNA Dealer)
- By quorum of board members present at convention on Friday.
- Award Presented on Sunday.
- Bourse Chairman Congratulatory Certificate (generated by Bourse Chairman) and \$100 off the next years table fees.

Robert W. Ross III SCNA YN of the Year Award: (SCYNOTY)

- For outstanding junior member.
- Must be less than 18 years of age as of the submission deadline; a member of a local club; and a member of the SCNA. Their achievements should be in a numismatic field and described in a written format. A picture of the YN is desired, but is not required.
- This award has morphed into the board sponsored A. M. Sheheen YN Scholarship and/or YN of the Year for SC.
- Notable recipients are John S. Brush and Shelby Plooster.

James Vernon Epps Membership Award: (SCJVEM)

- Given for most members recruited.
- Sponsored by the SCNA Board.
- Among recipients: Nancy D. King (2), Johnny T. King, Norman L. Boggs (all of Anderson, SC) Loran Ross (4), Donald D. McAlister (4), Tony Chibbaro (4), Sam Norris, Pascal Brock, I was the last recipient in @2009/10.
