The SCNA is celebrating our own South Carolina America the Beautiful quarter by offering graded proof silver and clad Fort Moultrie 2016 quarters at the convention.

A total of 205 will be available: 180 silver and 25 clad. These proof issue quarters will be graded by ICG and numbered 1-205. An individual may purchase a maximum of 5 quarters but only one clad quarter per person due to limited number. The SCNA board will sell via silent auction serial numbers 1 to 5 of the silver and clad graded proofs during the convention.

The cost of these special edition graded quarters is \$25.00 for the silver proof and \$5.00 for the clad proof.






